From Canada: Take the QEW to Ft. Erie and cross the Peace Bridge into the U.S. Take the Rt. 190-south to the Rt. 90-west and Rt 219 to Springville, NY. Parking will be on new Peters Road, just east of old 219, about a mile south of the Cattaraugus Creek bridge. (Take a left on new Peters Road, one mile past the Springville Country Club.)
